It was 0-Shot-Caw's 50th anniversary year—and we're sure we missed something.....

FROM THE PUBLISHERS

The cover is 167 megabytes of memory space on the computer. From what we can tell, there are but five 2005 patches from O-Shot-Caw 265 that are missing from the cover. Between the lodge's 50th anniversary and hosting the Section Conference, plus the National Jamboree, and you have a whole book of lodge items from just this past year.

And what was there that was made? Among the multitude,

- > 7 chenilles for the Lodge Executive Committee;
- > 2 LEC chenilles;
- > 1 LEC flap;
- > 8 flap and dangle sets for the National Jamboree, plus an additional flap;
- > three flaps, four dangles, three neckerchiefs, two chenilles, one service patch, one pin, one slide, and a bullion for hosting the Section Conference.

It would be easy to put the blame/ credit for all of the patches on just one lodge, but 2005 was, after all, a Jamboree year, and that comes with a slew of emblems of its own.

But in the meantime, a fun time was had by one and all at the recent Sunshine Trade-O-Ree, held in Orlando the weekend of February 10-11. For the first time in the history of the event, every table was sold prior to the start of the event (in fact, oversold). Some profits were made, some fortunes spent, but it was a fun, friendly event, as usual. Several new pieces came out prior to the weekend, and folks were friendly enough to lend out these patches for scanning purposes. Some of those are pictured here in this issue.

Camp Flying Eagle to close? Just one year after celebrating the 75th anniversary of Camp Flying Eagle, Southwest Florida Council is considering offers to sell the

property, and take advantage of the booming property values that accompany the encroaching development heading in its direction. As there has been with any other such land sale, there is a group of Scouters and other interested parties that are trying to stop any possible transaction. though nothing has been decided, the opposition is drawing media attention to their cause to save the camp from civilization.

While it would be a shame to lose a property that is one of the oldest camps in Florida, the reasons to take the money and run are compelling. If the camp is to remain open, the facilities are in need of improvement, to cost almost as much as the council may receive in its sale. Its location on the banks of the Manatee River is a beautiful setting, but as a consequence, the property is open to anyone traveling up and down the river, that may choose to explore the camp. And occasionally, the river will flood and flow through the middle of the camp. For Southwest Florida Council, this is not its primary camp property, as it was inherited with the takeover of Sunnyland Council in 1994.








NEW ISSUES

- > Despite the cover story, there are no new issues from O-Shot-Caw 265, at least in the first few months of 2006. Nor anything new from Aal-Pa-Tah 237, Semialachee 239, Echockotee 200, or Seminole 85.
- > Tipisa 326, however, is another story. The Brotherhood and Vigil 14 feathers (S-37, RED bdr; S-38, RST bdr) are now out. And the Vigil border already has two varieties: LBL details in the design (a) that matches the Brotherhood and Ordeal flaps, and a MBL detail variety (b). difference was first discovered at the Sunshine Trade-O-Ree. The 2006 S-4S Conference Host Lodge flap (S-39), the two host neckerchiefs (N-7, regular cloth; N-8, satin cloth), and the host dangle became available at the Spring Fellowship. released at that event was X-8, the CSP at the top of the lodge's three-piece NOAC set (also Central Florida Council S-??).

The chapters of Tipisa have been active as well. **Micconope** has two new patches: **X-8**, in an all-GRN monochrome, and the service patch in an all-RED monochrome (**X-9**). **Elauwit** has a new naked-blue-guy patch (**X-6**) for 2006, as does **Tomoka** (**X-7**). And one of the newest chapters is **Estiotee** Chapter, with their first patch (**X-1**).

- > This year is the 60th anniversary of Timuquan 340, and has been marked by the release of the event's flap (S-50), neckerchief (P-10), jacket patch (J-7), and chenille (C-4).
- > Osceola 564 is supposed to have their \$100 donation patch out at their Spring event (no picture yet). A medal has been made this year to recognize hose that serve in the Ordeal as an Elangomat.
- > From the panhandle: **Yustaga 385** has its two-piece NOAC 2006 set (**S-** , **X-**), available since the first of the year.

- > Almost as prolific in issuance has been Central Florida Council and Gulf Ridge Council. Central Florida has three FO\$ issues (not pictured, GMY bdr, for \$ over three years; SMY bdr, for \$ in one year; "Baden-Powell Society", for a \$300 donation), the aforementioned 2006 NOAC CSP, and a 2006 Philmont Trek CSP.
- > From Gulf Ridge Council are two Wood Badge CSPs: one with a GRN course number for attendees, and the other with a GMY course number, for members of the staff.
- > Both North Florida Council and Gulf Stream Council have issued their latest in their series of FO\$ CSPs, both for more than \$100 each.
- > Orders were being taken by Section S-4S at the 2005 Seminars for a neckerchief for the 30th anniversary of the event. Three moths later, they have finally been distributed (pictured inside).

NOAC issues coming.....

- * Echockotee 200 will have a two-piece set for NOAC, and an additional flap-shaped patch for Founders' Day.
- * and as mentioned before, Tipisa 326 will have a three-piece set (CSP, flap, and dangle). And this year, there is not supposed to be any mistaking the middle patch for anything but a flap.
