FROM THE EDITORS

Centennial year, 2010. Most of the time, the phrase “once if a lifetime” is a lot of hyperbole and puffery. Well, the use of the term for the BSA Centennial is accurate, only because most people aren't expecting to live to see the bicentennial.

But this the centennial year is expected to be pretty exciting, with a chance to remember the history of the previous 99 years. “Adventure Base 100”, the BSA traveling campus of history and examples of Scouting activities, will be passing through Florida in March, with stops in Tampa, Jacksonville, and Miami. And the BSA is preparing for the Centennial Jamboree, with the misfortune of happening in the middle of one of the worst economic downturns in the last 50 years.

The effects of the economy. The downturn of the economy has taken its toll on the hobby. Many prime pieces that are being sold on eBay have dropped in price, if they sell at all. The fervor for issuing high-retail emblems like chenilles and \$10 flaps has subsided, because the money is not there. We continue to face the problem that as fewer youth are getting involved in collecting patches than there are people getting out of collecting. Perhaps there can be a revival if lodges and councils will create issues that are less expensive and more available. We'll see.

Scouting is not cheap. Uniforms are almost too expensive for children that grow out of them after a year, activities are more expensive with additional fuel costs, fees, and insurance, and patch sales can't pay for everything like in years past. The lowest price found for attending the Jamboree from a Florida council was North Florida, charging \$1600 per person. Other councils are

charging as much as \$2200. This year's Section Conference has the smallest list of different items available in the trading Post in many years, perhaps as a consequence of the reduced numbers of collectors.

2009. The previous year saw quite a number of new items created by Florida's lodges and councils, with preparing for the Centennial and for the National OA Conference. The Winter issue of the newsletter has been the time that we have provided a list of the previous year's items, and to make snarky comments about the perennial high producers of emblems, O-Shot-Caw 265. But they are off the hook this year, as two lodges now take the prize. The lodge that created the most flaps in 2009 was not O-Shot-Caw (five), it was Echokotee 200, with nine. Creating the most emblems (flaps, odd-shapes, etc, that are not activities) was Aal-Pa-Tah 237, with twenty. What these two lodges had in common was that the multitude of the items created were strictly fundraisers: seven of the nine flaps for Echokotee, and six “campership” pieces by Aal-Pa-Tah.

The leader for Council Shoulder patches? Gulf Stream Council had ten (six fundraisers), followed by North Florida (three fundraisers)

NEW ISSUES

> **Central Florida Council** has a brochure for their 2010 "Friends Of Scouting" campaign (referred to in this newsletter as FO\$, for short). There are seven different donation levels, with each level rewarded with one of each of the items at the level below it. Five levels involve patches. The "Family" level donation of \$125 will get a round patch and FO\$ 2010 pin. The "Leadership" level donation of \$500 will also include a polo shirt, cap, and CSP with Ernest Thompson Seton. The "Character Partner" donation of \$1000 over three years will garner an additional CSP with the image of Dan Beard. A donation of \$1000 in a single year is the "Founder" level, and adds a CSP with the portrait of W. D. Boyce. At the top level donation of \$2010 ("Centennial Partner") includes all of the items with a CSP with E. Urner Goodman and a Tipisa Lodge tipi in the background. Will this now be considered a lodge item, the most expensive patch at the retail level in the Florida collection?

> **Seminole 85** has made their complete 2010 activity patch set available, which includes their five event patches, and a year patch. Except that the year patch has no date or year on it. Which means that the year patch is also to be classified as a jacket patch (**085-J-3**).

> In late 2009, the Vigil members of **Tipisa 326** came together for a gathering, and commemorated it with a stamped leather triangle, much like the one that was made in 2008. Is this considered an official Tipisa item? Depends on if you need it for your collection.

> The chapters of **Tipisa 326** have been busy in the last few months:

> **Astatula Chapter** issued a new emblem (**X-6**), commemorating the 100th anniversary of the BSA. Unless one notices the Tipisa tipi on the patch's quiver, one could not tell that this was a Tipisa item.

> **Estiote Chapter** has three new patches that were issued in late 2009: a small Ceremonies strip patch (**X-5**), and

Elangomat strip (**X-6**), and an arrowhead, commemorating the 40th anniversary of the Elangomat induction process (**A-1**). Another set of items with a hidden Tipisa tipi, and no lodge name or number.

> **Elauwit Chapter** (aka "the nekkid blue guy") also has a new patch (**X-17**). The tipi is a major feature of the design, but another chapter piece with no lodge name or number.

> Elauwit and **Waga Hlakgo Chapters** ran a combined event for Apopka Shores District, the 2010 Spring Cook-O-Ree. There were 300 patches made for attendees, and another 100 for staff.

> **Wewahitchka Chapter** had two new patches in late 2009, one with a lilac border for regular purchase (**X-15**), another with a GMY border for those meeting a service requirement (**X-16**). These have no lodge name or number, and the Tipisa tipi is repeated in a Seminole-style patchwork design.

> Several chapters are being merged in a council re-organization, resulting in some chapter names to disappear. **Wiquek Chapter** has issued a "death patch" (**R-1**), to mark their demise.

> **O-Shot-Caw 265** finally came out with their 2009-2010 Lodge Executive Committee flap (**S-131??**). A total of 200 were made. Not yet pictured (and not confirmed) are their 2009 Section Seminars contingent and Haunted Forest pieces.

> Not pictured: **Echokotee 200's Elemukulek Chapter** ran the River Bend District 2010 Camporee, with two patches with the Echokotee (but not the chapter name). One for attendees, another for staff.

> **North Florida Council** held their annual Winter Blast long-term camp program, where four CSPs were made. The 2009 Winter Blast had a week for Scouts (**SA-54??**) and Venturing (**SA-55??**), as well as a special week for Webelos (**SA-56??**). The fourth CSP was issued to staff (**SA-57??**). The new FO\$ SAP for 2010 has also been released (**SA-58??**). North Florida also issued another 2010 Jamboree strip, a fundraiser with the University of Florida logo.

THE RUMOR MILL

* **Seminole 85**, host of the 2010 Section S-4 Conference, will have a few items created for the event. Barring any last minute additions, there will be one flap, pocket patch, jacket patch, neckerchief, and chenille. An order form has also been created for a FourCorps flap.

* The Lodge Executive Committee of **Echokotee 200** approved the issuance of a special flap for the FourCorps program. No word yet as to how it will be issued, how many to be made, or the design. Thus far, fewer than ten lodge members have signed up to attend the Section event. The LEC has also authorized production of a Jamboree flap.

* **Tipisa 326** will be selling a special flap for the 2010 National Jamboree. The design will fit in with the rest of the Central Florida Council, with the theme of "Guitar Hero". Because nothing says Scouting, National Jamboree, or the BSA centennial like the video game "Guitar Hero".

* **North Florida Council** will be creating a set of patches for the National Jamboree, with a pirate theme. This set is said to consist of six JSPs (1/ troop plus one for council members on staff, and another designed by a youth member), four troop number patches, and a jacket patch.

notes & asides

+ In February, **Tipisa 326** hosted their Native American Weekend, an educational event to teach crafts, sing and dance, and history. Last year's event was cancelled due to poor planning, which was corrected for the 2010 weekend with greater advertising and better planning. Even with the event being opened up to anyone interested, not just Tipisa members or Arrowmen, registration was expected to come in at around 350 to 400; to handle that expectation, 500 patches were ordered.

As a result of better preparation, over 900 people attended, too late to order enough patches for everyone. Another order of 800 patches have been placed, one of the few events where the order for extras exceeded the original.

The Chapter merger news in Tipisa 326 has

not yet been completed. The Camporee patches for Halifax Shores District indicated the shared staffing duties of both **Waga Hlakgo** and **Elauwit** Chapters, both part of the merged district. After the lodge's Service Weekend in May, Elauwit will be split at the Orange-Seminole county line; half going to Waga Hlakgo, the other half to **Takachsin** Chapter. These changes are likely to result in new chapter names, and probably new chapter patches, including a possible death patch for Elauwit. **Estiote** Chapter will be split in half, with the north end joining **Woapalanne** Chapter, the south with **Astatula** Chapter. Also being merged out is **Wiquek**, rejoining with **Tomoka** Chapter, with the new entity retaining the Tomoka name. All together, eight of the fourteen chapters will be affected, leaving a total of eleven chapters.

+ The theme for the **Echokotee 200** activity patch series for 2010 is "Centennial Of Scouting". The weekend patch designs will feature important figures in the development of the Boy Scouts of America, and the year patch used the images of patches familiar to Scouts and Scouters in North Florida Council, arranged at random, like a collage. The middle of the design has a BSA logo stitched higher than the rest of the patch.

When the year patch was introduced at the Winter Fellowship, all 125 were sold. The lodge has ordered another 125 patches, but the second order is different. While the first run had a Jacksonville community strip in red and white colors, the second order has the same community strip in Cub Scout colors, matching what had been available for Cub uniforms in the 1930s and 1940s.

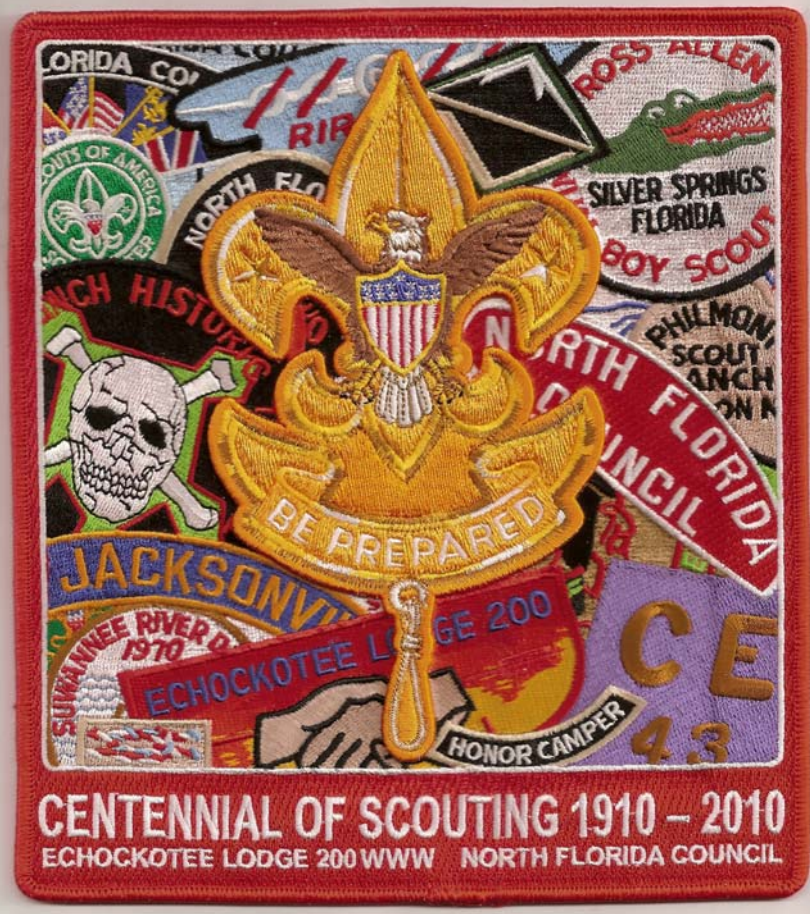
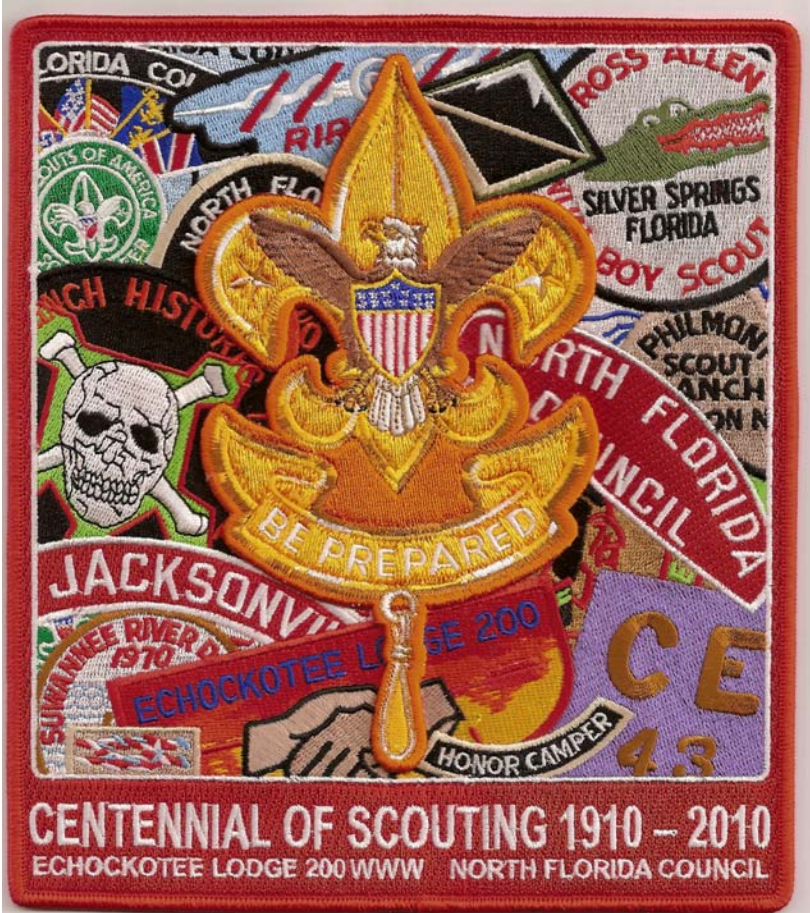

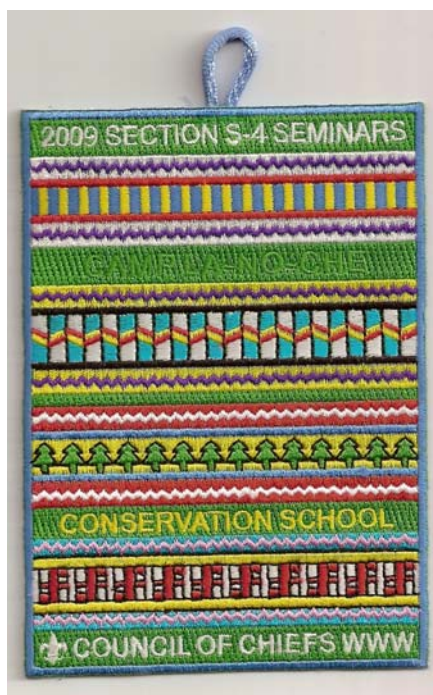

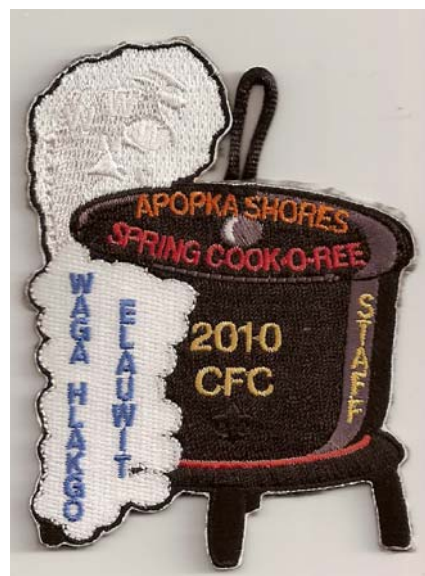
