# **NEW ISSUES**

> **O-Shot-Caw Lodge 265** finished the year with several new, hard-to-find issues. The lodge created two different two-piece sets for their "Breast Cancer" fundraising: one set with a WHT border on the flap, and a WHT button loop on the bottom (**F-33**, **X-53a**; 150 made)., the other with a PNK mylar border and a PNK button loop (**F-34**, **X-53b**; 50 made). In December was their annual Lodge Executive Committee flap (**F-35**), designed in the same style as their 2011-2012 activity patch series, with pictographs of different aspects of The Legend. The lodge's Vigil Committee marked their annual reunion with an undated patch (**R-7**).

Also created was a special, undated patch (R-8) that the lodge released at its 2012 Lodge Banquet event, commemorating the 100th anniversary of the first presentation of the Eagle Scout rank. The patch was available for sale, only to lodge members that were also Eagle Scouts.

- + Aal-Pa-Tah 237 is celebrating their 70th anniversary in 2012, and has created a flap for the occasion (S-109); 250 made. Additional event patches that are not part of this year's theme were also created; one for their 2012 "fast pass" (one payment for the year's events; 150 made), and a 2012 Palm Beach Trade-O-Ree patch (100 made).
- + **Tipisa 326** has made another regular issue flap (**S-45**), measuring 65mm x 129mm, so that the flap fits better on the pocket..

Some of its chapters have been busy as well. The crazy chickens at **Tosohatchee Chapter** have a regular patch (**X-10**), and a 2012 NOAC fundraiser (**X-11**). **Kikape Chapter** has joined in with the lodge's "Renaissance of Brotherhood" activity patch theme, with their own patch to honor Michelangelo (**R-1**). **Ayochatta Chapter** has a new patch for 2012 (**X-7**), actually available in 2011.

+ And new CSPs as well: **Central Florida Council** has joined other councils with a special Wood Badge SAP (**SA-??**), and a new, "official" Sea Scout 100th anniversary piece (**SA-??**).

- + North Florida Council held their annual Winter Blast resident camping event, and marked it with only two CSPs, one for all of the participants, another for staff (SA-??). For this year, the council has completed its "Scout Law" FO\$ fundraisers, one in full color for contributors, another in a PUR monochrome version for presenters.
- + West Central Florida Council has a new SAP for its' commissioners (SA-??), issued in late 2011.

# THE RUMOR MILL

- \* Semialachee Lodge 239, the host lodge of the 2012 Section S-4 Conference, will not be having the full gamut of host items as several other lodges have had in the past: probably a single flap, a patch, and a neckerchief.
- \* **Gulf Ridge Council** will be commemorating the 90th year of Camp Owen Browein, with a set of two CSPs, with matching flaps from **Seminole Lodge 85**. One of each set will be easy to obtain, the other will be much harder., due to issuance in more limited numbers.
- \* Timuquan Lodge 340 has an order form for their NOAC 2012 items: three flaps (regular, attendee, Founders' Day), a dangle pocket patch, and a back patch.
- \* Echockotee Lodge 200 is planning top have only one two-piece set for NOAC. No registration piece, and no Founders' Day flap at this time. There is already a contingent epaulet that has been distributed to those lodge members that have made their initial payments.
- \* **Seminole Lodge 85** is expecting to have three two-piece sets for NOAC.
- \* O-Shot-Caw Lodge 265 has plans for two tw0-piece sets for NOAC, as well as a special pocket dangle to be made available only to contingent members that are Eagle Scouts. This is to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the first awarding of the Eagle Scout rank.
- \* **Tipisa Lodge 326** will be making another three piece set for the National Conference.

# notes & asides

- + The theme for the activity patches for **Echockotee Lodge 200** for 2012 is "Camp Shands Structures". The Winter Fellowship event was held in early January, and Camp Shands was shrouded in a fog and smoke from a peat fire in the prairie next to the camp, a fire that had been burning since mid-November. So the lodge's Spring Fellowship will be held at Camp Echockotee, the first time in 44 years that the lodge will hold a Fellowship at their original home camp. To mark the occasion, a small patch is being made to mark the return, and a version of the Winter patch is being ordered, with the design rendered in differing shades of gray.
- + The 2012 activity patch theme for **Osceola Lodge 564** will be "Orange Crate Labels", featuring crate art from closed citrus packing houses from each of the four chapters of the lodge.
- + Aal-Pa-Tah Lodge 237's 2012 activity patch theme is a true "puzzle" set., with each weekend piece representing a letter in the word "GATOR", and a segment of the gator. Once assembled, the segments fit into the year patch, with two segments that fit like a jigsaw puzzle. There is also an "uncut" version of all of the weekend patches, together with the year patch.
- + Timuquan Lodge 340 has reorganized their chapters down to three, and are going back to the names of Tocobaga, Calusa, and Osceola Chapters. If those sound familiar, those are the three chapter names used by Timuquan from the mid-1960s into the 1980s.
- + Howard Gross and Chris Colebaugh have built a website that serves as a resource for Tipisa Lodge 326 items, down to the last chapter event bandana. While their chapter item numbering system has differences with what is on oaimages.com and this newsletter, it looks like a thorough virtual collection of all things Tipisa. It can be found at http://www.floridacsp.com/tipisa/index.html.
- + Collecting the old community and state strips have taken off into very valuable territory. Just one example on eBay: in February, a conglomeration of generic Cub Scout items included sewn BYS community and state strips for Seward, Alaska, sold for

\$900.01. A similar BYS set for Fort Smith, ARK. Sold for \$136.50.

Also on eBay, a major collector of Osceola 564 items recently sold his collection, with some rare pieces appearing for the first time in a while, including a 552 S-1 (\$329.50), 552 S-2 (\$76.52), 1984 SE-1 Conference Host (GRN cloth, \$154.01), a 564 1991 S-1 Conference Host flap with BRN turban band (\$143.50).

- + Rumor has it that a 1979 SE-6 Conference satin neckerchief (1/ Council of Chief member, 13 made) traded hands at the Sunshine Trade-O-Ree, for a low four figure amount.
- + A troop located in Keystone Heights has created a pseudo-OA troop number patch, complete with a BSA handclasp (much like the Echockotee Lodge totem), and an image of E. Urner Goodman., as he was that community's most famous resident.
- + The International Scouting Collectors Association (ISCA) will be running the pre-NOAC Trade-O-Ree at East Lansing. Michigan, from July 27 to the 30th, and will be open as the National Conference attendees It will be located at the arrive on campus. Munn Ice Hockey Arena, located on the Michigan State campus, across the street from where the incoming lodges will check in. There will also be an area set aside where youth members will be able to sell patches on behalf of their own lodges.
- + The condensation of the councils and lodges in the lower Michigan peninsula is moving at full speed. There will eventually be four field councils with four lodges in lower Michigan, where ten councils used to exist. The council in the Upper Peninsula to eventually disappear. This is still seen as an experiment by the BSA, and subject to be studied before determining that is to be implemented elsewhere.
- + Long Beach Area Council, California will become the next to last council to finally charter a new Order of the Arrow lodge. This will be the first new lodge that was not created by a merger or absorption in over forty years. Their current honor society, The Tribe of Talquiz, will continue to exist alongside the new lodge, and is expected to have its first Ordeal this summer.







